This club is proud to be a Region of the Antique Automobile Club of America (AACA); members must also be members of AACA. The region publishes a monthly newsletter, The Nuts & Bolts. And the region hosts an annual Celebration of Cars Show plus picnics, dinners, displays, and tours.

The aim of the AACA is the perpetuation of the pioneer days of automobiling by furthering the interest in and preserving of antique automobiles, and the promotion of sportsmanship and of good fellowship among all AACA members. The AACA uses the term "automobile" in a comprehensive sense to include all self-propelled vehicles intended for passenger use (cars, race vehicles, trucks, fire vehicles, motorcycles, powered bicycles, etc.). Similarly, the term includes various power sources, such as gasoline, diesel, steam and electric. The AACA holds countrywide competitive and noncompetitive events, such as meets and tours, where members are encouraged to participate. These are on a divisional basis offering a program within the reach of everyone.

Tours and activities relating to the hobby are sponsored, including the Revival Glidden Tour®. AACA has a recognized national judging system, maintains a Library & Research Center for its members, and maintains a Museum containing numerous displays of automotive history that is open to the public. AACA, has an outstanding Website, (http://www.aaca.org), where members may get current information, pay dues, register for meets and tours, and participate in active online forums. Members receive by mail an award-winning bi-monthly magazine, **The Antique Automobile.**

If antique vehicles interest you, you are encouraged to join by submitting this application along with your check for annual dues as listed above. Regular dues (\$20) are for either an individual or joint; Student dues (\$6) are for active students (with ID) and cover ages 16-25; Please include your AACA membership #, but if you are not already an AACA member, you may submit an AACA Membership Application or join online.
